Verse One (*Action – circular motion with hands*)

Verse Two (*Action – step forward, back*)

The people on the bus go in and out
In and out.....etc

Verse Three (*Action – go to window and show up and down*)

The windows on the bus go up and down
Up and down.....etc

Verse Four (*Action – use hand and motion to back*)

The driver on the bus says “move on back”
Move on back.....etc

Verse Five (*Action – shake up and down*)

The people on the bus go bumpity, bumpity, bump
Bumpity, bumpity, bump.....etc

Verse Six (*Action – pretend to cry*)

The babies on the bus go “wah, wah, wah”
Wah, wah, wah....etc

Verse Seven (*Action – hold hands to heart*)

The mamas on the bus say “I love you”
I love you.....etc

Options For Other Verses:

- The horn on the bus says “beep, beep, beep” (*Action – mime pressing horn*)
